International company Teleplan opens site in Mechanicsburg

Mechanicsburg, PA — November 20, 2013 — Teleplan, a global provider of after-market electronic repair services, officially opened a new plant in Hampden Township at 6350 Brackbill Boulevard. The company also has two similar plants in Mexico, not far from the US border. In total, Teleplan has 22 locations across Europe, North America, Asia and Australia. The company is celebrating 30 years of operation this year.
