Jubilee DayTM Offers Full Day of Free Entertainment

FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE: Mechanicsburg, PA – June 17, 2013 – Downtown Mechanicsburg is gearing up for the Mechanicsburg Chamber of Commerce's 85th Annual Jubilee Day™, the largest, longest-running one day street fair on the East Coast. The festival will take place on Thursday, June 20. In addition to over 300 businesses, crafters, retailers and food vendors, the festival also offers a full day of free entertainment, including live performances on two stages.

Vinyl Groov, a regional R&B group delivering sounds and style similar to that of The Four Tops and The Temptations, is this year's headline act. You can catch them at 7:00 PM at the Pinnacle Health Stage on East Main Street. Attendees will also enjoy performances by the Trez Music Rock and Jazz Bands, Jazz Me, Voxology, Disco Fever and Nate Myers & The Aces – all at the PA Lottery Stage on the square. In addition, the Pinnacle Health Stage will also feature several local and regional performers throughout the day, including The Perfect 5th Student and Teacher All Star Bands, Reach! Dance Troupe, and Rhythm on Main. For the full schedule, visit www.jubileeday.org.

Several radio stations will be present at Jubilee DayTM including WINK 104, 105.7 The X, Hot 93.5, and Z Country 106.7, all of whom are 2013 Jubilee DayTM Media Sponsors.

The popular children's petting zoo will be back again for 2013, offered by the Immanuel Alliance Church in Mechanicsburg. The free zoo will be set up behind Citizens Bank near the square. Pony rides will also return, offered by Encore Farms and Bits 'N' Pieces 4H Club from 3 to 8 pm, which will also be located behind Citizens. An assortment of thrilling amusement rides will be returning this year, as well, which will be located in the PNC Bank parking lot.

New attractions for 2013 include a mobile VF Outlet shopping experience housed within a vintage 1964 AirStream and CBS's Big Bang Theory car, both of which can be found on Market Street. The National Guard will also have the Patriot Chopper on display, the first of three custom bikes to be built by Orange County Choppers (OCC), which can be found on West Main Street in front of Clay's Exxon station. In addition, Verizon Wireless will be exhibiting their Indy Car show car on East Main Street.

"With upwards of 60,000 people who attend, it is important to note that we offer free parking and shuttle bus transportation to and from the event, from Mechanicsburg High School's parking lot, accessible from Williams Grove Road, and Immanuel Church on South Market Street in Mechanicsburg," explains Jeff Palm, Executive Director of the Mechanicsburg Chamber of Commerce.
