Mechanicsburg will drop wrench to welcome 2014

Mechanicsburg, PA — December 26, 2013 — The Mechanicsburg Chamber of Commerce will present the 10th Annual Wrench Drop in downtown Mechanicsburg on Tuesday, December 31 in front of Washington Fire Company at 53 East Main Street. The event kicks off at 10:30 p.m. with musical entertainment by DJ Bob Arbogast, sponsored by PNC Bank. An evening of music and games will lead to the countdown to midnight and the dropping of the ten and a half foot wrench adorned in lights.

"We are proud to offer yet another family-friendly New Year's Eve celebration to the community. We welcome everyone in the area to ring in the new year in Mechanicsburg," said Mechanicsburg Chamber of Commerce Executive Director Jeff Palm.

The galvanized steel wrench is the result of an Eagle Scout project by Sheldon Rodgers, a Mechanicsburg Area School District graduate. The first wrench was dropped on New Year's Eve 2004. The wrench commemorates the mechanics who settled in the area to repair wagons that were traveling west after crossing the Susquehanna River.
