IRS Grants Penalty Relief Due to COVID-19

Over the past two years, the IRS has experienced mail and processing backlogs due to the COVID pandemic. To help taxpayers impacted by these issues, the IRS is granting automatic penalty relief as it relates to late filing penalties for the following tax returns and information returns:

1099-MISC	990-PF
1099-NEC	990-T
1120	1040
1120S	1041
5471	1065

& More (For the full list, please consult with your tax advisor.)

Qualifying returns would have been filed for tax years 2019 or 2020. Late tax returns have to be filed before September 30, 2022.

Taxpayers do not need to do anything to take advantage of this program. Penalties will be abated or waived automatically, and any refunds generated will be sent back to taxpayers via checks or credited to still existing balances due.

The program is expected to be completed by the end of September 2022. Please contact your Trout CPA professional for additional information, questions, or assistance.
