Identity theft and fraud are on the rise; F&M Trust offers resources to public, customers



CHAMBERSBURG, Pa. – Since 2019, the number of incidents of fraud and identity theft reported in the United States has increased from 3.4 million to 5.9 million – nearly 74 percent. With statistics like this, chances are very good that you or someone you know has been the target of identity theft or fraud.

Pennsylvania and Maryland have some of the highest rates of these crimes in the country. Pennsylvania (14th) and Maryland (12th) rank in the top 20 for identity theft reports per 100,000 people and in the top 10 (Pennsylvania, No. 7; Maryland, No. 2) for other fraud and scams.*

It takes an average of 18 months for a victim to recover from the damage done to their credit or their reputation. F&M Trust knows how troubling this can be and provides a variety of resources for people to protect themselves from identity theft and fraud on the Money Moves section of its website.

There one can find such articles as:

- How to Protect Yourself After a Data Breach
- How Scammers Posing as Grandkids are Stealing Thousands of Dollars
- How to Avoid a Student Loan Debt Relief Scam
- How to Spot a Charity Scammer
- Everything You Need to Know About Gift Card Scams

The bank also offers identity theft aid through its YourBux benefits program as part of its YourWay Plus and YourWay Premier checking accounts. Here are some other helpful tips to protect against identity theft and fraud, provided by F&M Trust Security Officer Ray Wills:

- Review your credit report at least annually. Get a free credit report at www.annualcreditreport.com or contact any of the three credit reporting agencies (Experian, Equifax, TransUnion).
- Consider placing a free credit freeze on your report. This makes it difficult for identity thieves to open new accounts in your name because most creditors need to see your credit report before they approve a new account.
- You may want to place a fraud alert on your file if your personal identifying information has been exposed but you haven't been the victim of identity theft.
- If a company responsible for exposing your information offers you free credit monitoring, take advantage of it.
- File your income taxes as early as you can. Scammers will use your Social Security number to get a tax refund or even apply for a job. Respond to letters (not calls, emails or text messages) from the IRS immediately.

Victims of identity theft or fraud should file a report with the Federal Trade Commission (FTC) at https://reportfraud.ftc.gov. Each report helps the FTC and its partners in law enforcement to take action to stop scams and impersonators.

FREE TAX PREPARATION!

Families (2 or more people) who made \$60,000 or less and individuals who made \$45,000 or less in 2022 may be eligible to receive FREE tax preparation through the Money in Your Pocket (MIYP) program Review the following information BEFORE arriving at a site.

You MUST bring the following documents to have your taxes prepared: Valid photo ID (driver's license, military ID, etc.) for taxpaver and sport

- Valid photo to (unres succese, timular jub, etc.) for ladpaper and spotse.
 Original Social Security card or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) for you, your spouse, your children and other dependents included in your tax return.
 Your <u>current</u> Identity Protection PIN number issued by the IRS (if you have one) for <u>each year's</u> taxes that you need prepared.
- Printed copies of all year-end tax forms you have received in the mail. (We cannot use electronic files from phones.) If you received health care from the marketplace, bring your form 1095-A. (We cannot prepare your return without it.)

Also bring the following information if it is available:

- Previous year's federal and state tax returns. (We can only access prior year returns for clients who used MIYP last year.)
- If you wish to have your refund deposited directly into can buy our checking or savings account, bring a blank check or other documentation from your bank/credit union that shows your account number and the routing transit number.
- If you expect to claim a credit for child or dependent care, bring the child care provider's address and Employer Identification Number (EIN) or their Social Security number. **MASKS MAY BE REQUIRED AT SITES**
