# **County Commissioners Call for Resident to Fill Executive Committee Vacancy**

Interested candidates for the Cumberland Area Economic Development Corporation should apply by Friday, April 14.

The Cumberland County Board of Commissioners is looking for residents who would be interested in serving on the Cumberland Area Economic Development Corporation (CAEDC) Executive Committee. The commissioners, as the corporate members of CAEDC, are looking for a community-minded candidate to fill the vacant position.

The Executive Committee includes the Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, and Treasurer of the CAEDC Board of Directors, and an individual designated by the Board of Commissioners. The Executive Committee provides recommendations to the Board of Directors, evaluates day-to-day operations, employee relations, and implements recommendations from the CEO for day-to-day operations.

### Criteria for consideration:

- Knowledge of nonprofit corporations, including governance and organizational development issues.
- Knowledge of economic development and entrepreneurship, workforce development, or tourism and marketing.

The candidate will serve until January 2024 and is subject to the appointment or re-appointment by the Cumberland County Commissioners. The executive meetings are held on the second Tuesday of every month from 8 - 9:15 a.m.

The corporation is led by an executive director who reports to a board of directors. Members of the board of directors are appointed by the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners.

# FREE TAX PREPARATION!

Families (2 or more people) who made \$60,000 or less and individuals who made \$45,000 or less in 2022 may be eligible to receive FREE tax preparation through the Money in Your Pocket (MIYP) program Review the following information BEFORE arriving at a site.

### You MUST bring the following documents to have your taxes prepared:

- Valid photo ID (driver's license, military ID, etc.) for taxpayer and sport
- Value prison to Crimer's incresse, limitary to, etc., for lapayer and spouse.
   Original Social Security card or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) for you, your spouse, your children and other dependents included in your tax return.
   Your <u>current</u> Identity Protection PIN number issued by the IRS (if you have one) for <u>each year's</u> taxes that you need prepared.
- Printed copies of all year-end tax forms you have received in the mail. (We cannot use electronic files from phones.)
- If you received health care from the marketplace, bring your form 1095-A. (We cannot prepare your return without it.)

#### Also bring the following information if it is available:

- Previous year's federal and state tax returns. (We can only access prior year returns for clients who used MIYP last year.)
- If you wish to have your refund deposited directly into your checking or savings account, bring a blank check or other documentation from your bank/credit union that shows your account number and the routing transit number.
- If you expect to claim a credit for child or dependent care, bring the child care provider's address and Employer Identification Number (EIN) or their Social Security number.
