Meet the Chamber's 2022 Charity of Choice: GFWC Mechanicsburg Program for Veterans

General Federation of Women's Club Mechanicsburg (GFWC) President Pam Fleck:

"It is so wonderful for the Mechanicsburg Chamber of Commerce to recognize the efforts of GFWC Mechanicsburg members by selecting them as the chamber's "Charity of Choice" this year! The grant from the chamber will be utilized to assist in the club's undertakings to support the tiny home village for homeless veterans!

GFWC Mechanicsburg is currently working with Veterans Outreach to outfit the 15 tiny homes being constructed for homeless veterans in Central PA. The members will be purchasing and pre-washing towels, sheets, etc. to set up the beds and bathrooms with necessities. A fundraiser was held by the club this past March, "Flavors of Mechanicsburg", to help raise money for the project. Over \$3,000 was raised during the event. All money raised by GFWC Mechanicsburg stays locally to support community organizations like the Simpson Library, New Hope Ministries After School program, Cumberland/Perry Counties Domestic Violence Shelter (signature project of GFWC) and others. The Mechanicsburg Museum was founded by this club!

GFWC Mechanicsburg is an active member in the Mechanicsburg Chamber of Commerce as well and really appreciates the support given by the chamber! Jeff Palm and staff were of great help with setting up our event last March and is always available as a resource. Being nominated as the "charity of choice" this year is such an honor and we appreciate the recognition of our work!"

Veterans Outreach of Pennsylvania and the tiny home village:

Veterans Outreach is a 501(c)3 nonprofit organization whose mission is to combat homelessness among Veterans by providing support and services needed to promote an empowered life filled with strength and purpose. The Veterans Tiny Home Village is being constructed on a 5-acre parcel along the Susquehanna River that was generously donated by a private family. The village will consist of 15 tiny homes surrounding a Community Center that will provide needed services to assist in the transition to more permanent housing.

GFWC Mechanicsburg's contribution to this project will provide the necessary linens and personal care items needed by the residents during their tenure at the village. This supply will not benefit the veteran just as they live in their home at the village, but will become their personal property as they move on to their permanent home. The GFWC Mechanicsburg is looking to provide an ample supply of products to offer a base for resupply through numerous transitions.

F&M Trust installs AEDs at each of its community banking locations

According to the American Heart Association, more than 350,000 people will suffer cardiac arrest this year. That's someone every 90 seconds.

Recognizing the importance of employee and customer safety, F&M Trust recently installed automated external defibrillators (AEDs) at each of its 22 community offices, its mortgage center in Camp Hill, and its regional headquarters in Harrisburg. The bank has three AEDs at its corporate headquarters in Chambersburg.

F&M Trust Security Officer Ray Wills suggested the devices be placed in all bank locations, and the bank's Wellness Committee saw the project through to completion with the help of F&M Trust's facilities department, which installed the AEDs.

"Our employees care not only about the health and safety of one another, but they show genuine care and concern for those living in our communities," F&M Trust President and CEO Tim Henry said. "This project to place potentially lifesaving AEDs at each of our locations is yet another example of that altruistic spirit."

Currently, the only way to restore a regular heart rhythm during cardiac arrest is to use an AED. And because the average response time for first responders once 911 is called is 8 to 12 minutes, having access to an AED and knowing how to use it can save a life.

"Immediate CPR and defibrillation are key to our goal of doubling the survival rate of cardiac arrest by 2030, and we are grateful for local businesses, organizations, and trusted community leaders like F&M Trust who are stepping up to help us reach this goal," said Ashley Schade, Regional Vice President of Development for the American Heart Association. "Improving access to AEDs wherever people live and work strengthens this key link in the chain of survival."



CAEDC Launches Two Tourism Grants

The Cumberland Area Economic Development Corporation (CAEDC) through its destination marketing arm, the Cumberland Valley Visitors Bureau, is announcing the return of tourism-focused grants. The returning Tourism Product Development Grant and a new grant, the Tourism Recovery Grant, will launch on Monday, August 28th.

The Tourism Product Development (TPD) Grant is intended to increase the number or products, experiences and services that draw overnight visitors to the Cumberland Valley. Awarded grant projects will increase the number of visits, length of stays and spending by visitors in the County. Applicants for the TPD Grant can request between \$25,000-250,000 (previous TPD grant capped at \$100,000).

The Tourism Product Development Grant has been on hiatus since mid-2020.

The new Tourism Recovery Grant is designed to help tourism-related industries recover from the Covid-19 Pandemic. Applicants can request between \$2,500-\$10,000 in funding for this program. The grant can be utilized for the purchase of machinery and equipment, marketing to new audiences, development of new experiences and deferred maintenance that increases tourism or enhance the visitor experience.

For both programs, applicants must provide at least \$0.50 match for each dollar awarded. "We're excited to re-launch tourism grant opportunities for many businesses in the Cumberland Valley as they continue to rebuild and find new ways to highlight our area as a tourism destination" said CAEDC Marketing Manager, Ashley Kurtz.

CAEDC began offering tourism grants in 2010 and has awarded over \$1.9 million to 199 projects. Notable grant projects include a large outdoor entertainment area at Midway Bowling Alley, two Escape Rooms at Grand Illusion Hard Cider, portions of the Cumberland Valley Rail Trail, including the Conrail Museum, a new performance space at the Central Pennsylvania Youth Ballet, and a tasting room at Winery At The Long Shot Farm.

The Winery at The Long Shot Farm Co-Owner Tina Weyant said "We have been growing grapes and berries in the Cumberland Valley for many years, and we are so thankful for the generous support from CAEDC, allowing us to share our passion for making wine."

CAEDC is Accepting Applications for LSA Grants

The Local Share Account (LSA), a statewide grant program opened on Friday, September 1, 2023 and interested non-profit applicants can apply through the Cumberland Area Economic Development Corporation (CAEDC).

CAEDC is seeking applicants who are a non-profit organization, need funding for projects between \$25,000-\$1,000,000, and either have an economic development component, or grow overnight stays for visitors in the region.

Eligible uses include:

- Acquisition
- Construction
- Demolition
- Infrastructure
- Purchase of vehicles, machinery and/or equipment (excluding unforms, protective equipment, consumable supplies, and furniture)
- Planning, consulting, and design costs related to planning projects.
- Engineering, design, and inspection, to include permitting fees, for construction projects not to exceed 10% of the total grant award.
- Administrative costs of the grantee for the purposes of administering the grant.
 Administrative costs may not exceed 2% of the total grant request.
- Contingency costs not to exceed 5% of documented construction and infrastructure costs.

Interested, qualified applicants can apply on CAEDC's online application at CumberlandBusiness. com/lsa-application or by contacting staff.

The Application window is September 1- November 30, 2023.

The LSA Grant is funded through the PA Race Horse Development and Gaming Act (Act 2004-71), as amended, which provides for the distribution of gaming revenues through the Commonwealth Financing Authority (CFA) to support projects in the public interest within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.
