

Cumberland County Planning Commission Seeking Resident to Fill Vacancy

*Applications are due to the Planning Commission Office by Nov. 21;
Term begins Jan. 2026*

The Cumberland County Planning Commission is accepting applications to fill a vacancy on its board. Qualified applicants must be Cumberland County residents and willing to serve a four-year term beginning Jan. 2026.

Board members are expected to attend the commission's monthly meetings, held at 7:30 a.m. on the third Thursday of each month. Residents interested in contributing to the county's planning and development efforts are encouraged to apply. Experience in planning is helpful but not required.

The Cumberland County Planning Commission partners with its urban, suburban, and rural communities to create and implement plans that promote economic development, provide more housing and transportation choices, and protect clean air, land, and water.

A commission subcommittee will review applications, conduct interviews, and recommend potential members to the Cumberland County Board of Commissioners, who will make the final appointment decisions.

How to Apply: To be considered, residents need to complete an [application](#) and submit a one-page resume. Submission of application materials is due to the Cumberland County Planning Commission Office by Friday, Nov. 21, 2025.



This town hall is an important opportunity to learn more about the legislation Rep. Fink and I introduced to eliminate school property taxes and finally deliver meaningful relief to Pennsylvania homeowners. We will walk through how this proposal creates a fairer, ability-to-pay funding model, one that gives you greater control over your own finances and ends the pressure placed on families whose tax bills rise simply because of where they live.



CAEDC 2026 Tourism Grant Applications Now Open

2026 Tourism Grant Opportunities

Beginning Thursday, November 6, 2025, CAEDC invites local businesses, nonprofits, and event organizers to apply for 2026 tourism grant funding. Three distinct opportunities are available:

- Tourism Product Development Grant - Supports physical product development projects seeking between \$25,000 and \$500,000 for creating new tourism experiences, including construction, furniture and fixtures, equipment and more.
- Tourism Partnership Grant – Offers funding from \$2,500 to \$10,000 for smaller-scale product development projects aimed at expanding tourism products, experiences, or services that attract overnight visitors to Cumberland Valley.
- Destination Sales Grant – Provides \$3,000 to \$10,000 for multi-day event expenses, including bid fees, facility or shuttle rentals, speaker or performer fees, and marketing or advertising costs.

Tourism grant applications are reviewed and approved quarterly, and the final deadline to apply for 2026 grants is November 6, 2026.

Eligible applicants can apply for up to \$2,500 in event registration reimbursement, with a maximum of \$5,000 being reimbursed to any one organization in a calendar year. This support is designed to open must doors and remove barriers so that partners can participate in the events that matter most.

Applicants should review the full program [guidelines](#) that include details on eligibility, requirements and the reimbursement process. Forms should be submitted at least one month prior to the event you wish to attend.

In honor of America's upcoming 250th anniversary, Cumberland County is joining communities across the Commonwealth in the *Bells Across PA* initiative by placing a ceremonial bell at Veterans Memorial Courtyard next to Cumberland County's historic courthouse in Carlisle, Pa.

The Bells Across PA project is part of America250PA, Pennsylvania's official commemoration of the nation's semiquincentennial. The initiative will feature artist-designed bells installed throughout Pennsylvania through 2026, each symbolizing Pennsylvanian's unique role in shaping the nation's history and future.

Cumberland County's bell will be created by Carlisle artist Phil George, whose design "250 Years of Cumberland County," reflects the region's deep roots in American history, its rich traditions in agriculture, and diverse wildlife. The bell stand will be designed and built by students at the Carlisle Center for Careers and Technology. The bell will be installed before the end of 2025, and will be unveiled at a ceremonial event which will be announced.

This commemorative installation is made possible through the support of the Cumberland Area Economic Development Corporation (CAEDC)/Cumberland Valley Visitors Bureau, the county's designated tourism and economic development agency.
